### CHRIS MAHER '79

Retired, EY

Chris retired from EY in June 2017. He has been retained by EY through June 2021 as a senior advisor to assist banking organizations with critical transformation projects covering risk management, capital management and compliance programs. Chris joined EY from the Federal Reserve Bank of New York in 1993. At the NY FRB, he managed examinations of banking organizations and nonbank subsidiaries. He headed the NY FRB's field investigations of Banca Nazionale del Lavoro and Bank of Credit and Commerce International. Prior to leaving the FRB, Mr. Maher was seconded to the IMF for a short term technical assistance project to establish a bank supervision function at the Central Bank of Turkmenistan. Earlier this year, Chris was an expert witness for the US Attorney's Office and Federal Bureau of Investigation.
